


RECONCILIATION BRIDGE CALGARY, ALBERTA June 2019

PROBLEM: Encapsulation of Rust and Lead Based Paint.








The Reconciliation Bridge connects downtown Calgary to north-central communities in Calgary. The bridge is an important part of the Bow River pathway system.




SOLUTION: Apply 2 coats cross hatched of <u>RUSTGRIP</u>® a <u>patented</u> and <u>certified</u> Functional Coating for Encapsulation of Rust and Bio-hazardous materials.











Industry Best Practice and Project Specifications: 2 coats cross hatched at 6 mils WFT per coat to a TOTAL of 12 mils WFT which equals 6 mils DFT (including the 2 mils profile gives 4 mils DFT over the highest peak) applied at +5 F over dew point.
