

Tyson Foods - Wisconsin July 2021

PROBLEM: This section of pipe with a maximum temperature of 200F \ 93C did not meet the OSHA standard of 140F \ 60C and represented a potential burn hazard to employees. In addition, it needed to be protected from the possibility of dripping oils.

SOLUTION: Insulate the pipe with 150 mils \ 3.8 mm DFT of <u>HSC® Coating</u> and top coat with <u>RUSTGRIP</u> ® to protect from the dripping oils. It now meets OSHA standards. <u>BROCHURE</u>.
